Investment Objective & Strategy

Fund objective:

To achieve long term capital growth by identifying fundamentally mis-valued businesses which will generate superior returns over time.

Investment process:

- Equity positions taken in companies we believe to be undervalued based on under-recognised change
- Ideas generated by extensive company visits & proprietary research library
- Investments made using an 18-24 month time horizon seeking a 50% minimum return hurdle
- Portfolio is concentrated (25-35 large-mid cap equities) and is region, sector and style agnostic

Monthly Commentary

The GEF (USD A class) performed poorly in May and was down -7.8% underperforming the MSCI All Country World benchmark by 2%. The funds best performer was Mowi, the Norwegian salmon farmer whilst Galaxy Entertainment, Murata Manufacturing, Fedex and others detracted from performance. Within sectors, Consumer Discretionary and Financials dragged whilst Communication Services and Industrials contributed positively. The fund did not add any new positions in May.

Mowi was up 8.3% in May contributing 0.5% of attribution. During the month, an algae bloom hit the northern areas of Norway leading to a significant loss of fish. Mortality and early harvesting removes future supply from the market which in turn means higher prices. Higher prices directly benefit Mowi as the world's largest salmon farmer hence the strong stock performance during the month.

Hexcel was up 3.1% in May contributing 0.3% of attribution. A solid investor update during the month highlighted the long-term aerospace content opportunity. New planes are seeing higher penetration of carbon fibre composites as a structural material due to weight and strength advantages with Hexcel a key beneficiary. Recent Boeing 737MAX issues potentially mean an earlier than expected new plane development which is a growth catalyst.

Galaxy Entertainment was down 19.1% in May resulting in a 0.4% drag to performance. The company reported a poor first quarter due to weak VIP business with a higher proportion of lower margin mass traffic. There was also a smoking ban which was a negative. Overall, future growth prospects remain positive as new visitations to Macau are strong with new construction adding significantly more rooms (currently hotels are at full capacity) for Galaxy.

Murata Manufacturing was down 19% in May resulting in a 0.4% drag to performance. The quarterly report was weak on operating profit in part due to a large write off on legacy equipment. Guidance was also lower than expected due to lower communication module expectations linked to smartphone caution. Importantly, there continues to be a positive demand mix shift to more auto with highly profitable MLCCs which is in line with the investment case.

Fedex was down 18.6% in May resulting in a 0.4% drag to performance. Trade concerns between the USA, China and other countries continue to put pressure on global logistic companies with Fedex badly affected. The integration of the European TNT business continues to be a challenge with lowered profitability expectations. Despite the trade headwinds, the e-commerce opportunity remains sizeable with a favourable industry structure set to benefit the large players
